



CONISTER BANK ARENA EVENTING CHALLENGE

27th April, 5th and 26th October, 10th and 16th November 2019

Class 1: Beginners 60cm – Rider any age to be suitably mounted. For the nervous and novice!

Class 2: Intro 70cm – Junior

Class 3: Intro 70cm – Senior

Class 4: Prelim 80cm – Junior

Class 5: Prelim 80cm – Senior

Class 6: Pre-novice 90cm – Junior

Class 7: Pre-novice 90cm – Senior

Class 8: Novice 100cm – Rider any age, horse/pony any height

Class 9: Intermediate 105/110cm – Rider and age, horse/pony any height.

Entry Rules

You can only enter two classes per horse/pony. Entry fee £12.00 per class. Start times will be available on the Kennaa Riding Club Facebook page the Friday afternoon prior to the event.

Entries close at **1pm on Thursday** before each event. **No late / text entries will be accepted.**

Format for 2019 (changes to 2018 in bold)

- The course consists of nine show jumps followed immediately with a simulated cross-country course of 10 jumps within the same arena and finishes with a show jump “joker” fence set **up to 10cm higher than the rest of the course. The joker fence is a compulsory fence and must be jumped; failure to jump before passing through the finish will be classed as an error of course**
- There will be a maximum of 20 jumping efforts in total
- The whole course will be timed, with optimum times set as follows: **70cm – 340mpm; 80/90cm – 360mpm; 100cm and 105/110cm – 375mpm**
- Penalties will be awarded at 0.4 penalties for every second in excess of the optimum time. **Every commenced period of one second in excess of five seconds under the optimum time will be penalised by 0.4 time penalty.** Time limit is twice the optimum time. Stop watches are not permitted
- You must wear a correctly fitting and compliant body protector and hat **(See BRC rules on current hat and body protector guidelines)** and the hat must have a chin strap securely fastened at all times when mounted and have NO fixed peak, eg a skull cap with silk is acceptable. Cross country colours are optional. Hair must be tied up above collar length
- The winner will be the competitor with the lowest number of penalties. In the event of a tie the winner will be the one closest to but under the optimum time. **Clear rounds take precedence over jumping faults, ie a rider clear with four time faults would be placed above a rider with four jumping faults**
- There will be a drawn order and approximate start times will be given in advance of the day. **The course will be open for inspection at least 30 minutes prior to the event start and prior to class 6**
- All riders must abide by the rules and terms and conditions of Kennaa Riding Club
- The judges’ decision is final.

Prizes/Points

The winner of each class will win a prize generously sponsored by Conister Bank. All presentations will be mounted and rosettes will be to **sixth** place.

Points to sixth place, plus one point to every competitor who completes a round. Points will be accrued at every round and the winner of the most points for their class/section will be awarded a winner's rug at the final round. **Competitors must take part in at least three events to qualify for points prizes.**

On taking part in your first 2019 round you will receive a fabulous Conister Bank prize.

Please remember that for safety arena eventing is about jumping clear in a forward rhythm, not galloping flat out!!!
