- Class 7 PYO test E50 (2007) Q, M71 (2002) Q, AM93 (2004) Q

#### Notes for Entry

\*Q = qualifying class for the Tri-Star Tilly Mint Trophy.

Classes 1, 3, 5 and 7 are championship league classes, with prelim and novice split into junior/senior leagues.

Horses and ponies may only enter three classes per day. If it would help you to have your test read, we would be more than happy to do so if someone is available. Just let us know on the day.

### 2020 UNAFFILIATED DRESSAGE LEAGUE CHAMPIONSHIP

#### The Tri-Star Tilly Mint Trophy

The league will run over the year with points awarded at our eight unaffiliated dressage shows: 4<sup>th</sup> January, 1<sup>st</sup> February, 15<sup>th</sup> March, 29<sup>th</sup> April, 27<sup>th</sup> May, 8<sup>th</sup> July, 7<sup>th</sup> October and 14<sup>th</sup> November.

Points will be awarded according to the percentage scores achieved as per British Dressage's scale:

60.00 – 61.99%	1 point
62.00 – 63.99%	2 points
64.00 – 65.99%	3 points
66.00 – 67.99%	4 points
68.00 – 69.99%	5 points
70.00 – 71.99%	6 points
72.00 – 73.99%	7 points
74.00 – 75.99%	8 points
76.00 – 77.99%	9 points
78.00 – 79.99%	10 points
80.00%+	11 points

There will be separate junior and senior leagues for preliminary and novice. Other levels (introductory, elementary and above) will not be split. There will be a champion and reserve at the end of the year for each league. Where there is more than one class at each level on the schedule, points will only be awarded to the horse/pony and rider combinations in the second class at that level. Points awarded for introductory classes will not count towards the unaffiliated championship trophy.

The horse/pony and rider combination with the greatest number of points overall (excluding intro points) will receive the Tri-Star Tilly Mint trophy. This trophy has been kindly donated by Gilly Hadfield in memory of her lovely mare Tilly, who competed regularly and successfully in dressage at Kennaa. The trophy will be awarded annually for unaffiliated dressage.
