



CONISTER BANK ARENA EVENTING CHALLENGE

29th Apr, 26th May, 14th July, 15th Sept, 6th Oct 2018

Class 1 Crosspoles – Rider any age to be suitably mounted. This class is aimed at genuine novices/young riders and horses/first timers etc.

**Class 2 Beginners 60cm – Rider any age to be suitably mounted. For the nervous and novice!
Combinations entering classes 1 and 2 are not eligible to compete in class 5 or above**

Class 3 Intro 70cm - Junior

Class 4 Intro 70cm - Senior

Class 5 Prelim 85cm - Junior

Class 6 Prelim 85cm – Senior

Class 7 Pre Novice 95cm – Rider any age – Horse/pony any height

Class 8 Novice 105cm - Rider any age – Horse/pony any height

Class 9 Intermediate 110/115cm - Rider and age – Horse/pony any height

Entry Rules

You can only enter two classes per horse/pony. Entry Fee £12.00 per class and a start fee of £5 per person will be required on the day for medical cover. Start times will be available on the Kennaa Riding Club website and Facebook page the Friday afternoon prior to the event.

Entries close at 1pm on Thursday before each event. **No late / text entries will be accepted.**

****NEW FORMAT FOR 2018****

- The arena eventing will consist of a show jumping course and then straight onto a simulated cross country course within the same arena using the “Jump 4 Joy” arena eventing fences, with the final “joker” fence being a show jump set 10cm higher than the course. An alternative final fence at class height will be set which takes a longer route
- The whole course will be timed, with optimum times set (70cm and below - 350mpm, 85/95cm - 360mpm and 105/110cm - 375mpm)
- Penalties will be awarded at 0.4 penalties for every second in excess of the optimum time. Time limit is twice the optimum time. Stop watches are not permitted
- There will be no more than 20 jumping efforts in total
- You must wear a correctly fitting and compliant body protector and hat (see Club rules on current hat and body protector guidelines) and the hat must have a chin strap securely fastened at all times when mounted and have NO fixed peak, eg a skull cap with silk is acceptable. Cross country colours are optional. Hair must be tied up above collar length
- The winner will be the competitor with the lowest number of penalties. In the event of a tie the winner will be the one closest to but under the optimum time with a clear round
- There will be a drawn order and approximate start times will be given in advance of the day. The course will only be open for walking before the class starts
- All presentations will be mounted, and rosettes and points will be to third place
- All riders must abide by the rules and terms and conditions of Kennaa Riding Club
- **The judges’ decision is final**

Prizes/Points

Points will be awarded as follows:

Completion of round - 1 point; 3rd place - 2 points; 2nd place - 4 points; 1st place - 6 points.

Points will be accrued at every round and the winner of the most points for their class/section will be awarded a winner's rug at the final round.
