NOTES FOR ENTRY

Team Format:

Teams consist of four riders, with no more than two team members competing at the same level. Scores will be counted across both affiliated and unaffiliated classes.

- The same horse or pony can be ridden by more than one rider in a single team or different team
- Please state on your entry which performance of each horse/pony on the day will count towards the team score.

Eligibility and Scoring:

- Team entries must be declared before the entry deadline—please include your team name in the notes column when entering.

- Riders may not compete below their current skill and experience level. The test counting towards the team score must be at, or above, the highest level previously competed by the horse and rider combination.
- Lead rein riders are not eligible for the team event, but are very welcome to compete in Class 2.
- All riders must be suitably mounted.

Results:

- **Class winners** will be the competitor with the highest individual percentage.
- **Team winners** will be determined by combining the percentages of all four team members. The team with the highest total wins. In the event of a tie, collective marks will be combined, and the highest total will determine the winner.

Prizes:

Prizes will be awarded to the top three teams. If possible, please be available for the presentation – date / location of this will be confirmed closer to the time of the competition.

You do not need to be part of a team to take part—**this event is open to all riders.**

Kennaa Riding Club dressage competitions are run under British Dressage Rules. Please visit britishdressage.co.uk for further details.

Class Limits:

- Horses and ponies may enter up to four classes per day at Novice level or below.
- At Elementary level or above, horses/ponies are limited to three tests per day.
- If you would find it helpful to have your test read, we're happy to assist—*providing we have someone available.*

Online entries are preferred; paper entries **will** be charged a booking fee of £1.50.
